Knowing how to perform a ventilation with a BVM takes skill. It also takes longer to master this skill than learning compressions. Once you know how to perform ventilations to a high standard, accuracy declines in a month or two.


Master Rate of Inspiration

See It As You Do It

VOLUME See the volume as air goes into the lungs

TIMER See the time you are squeezing the bag

Squeeze the BVM evenly and slowly
Deliver 500ml to 700ml in 1 second.




Tidal Value of Ventilations
